

We have three large bins overflowing with lost and found items.



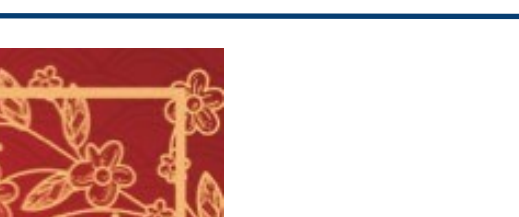

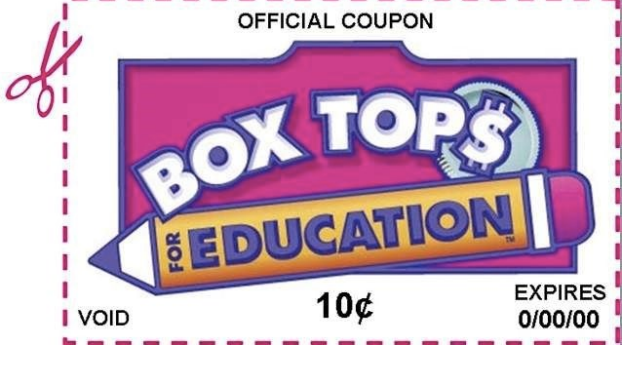
Mark the date for Heritage's Chinese New Year Celebration coming up on Thursday, Feb 7 from 6-8pm.
