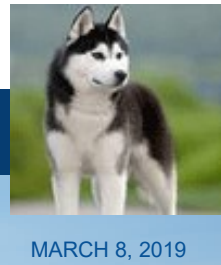

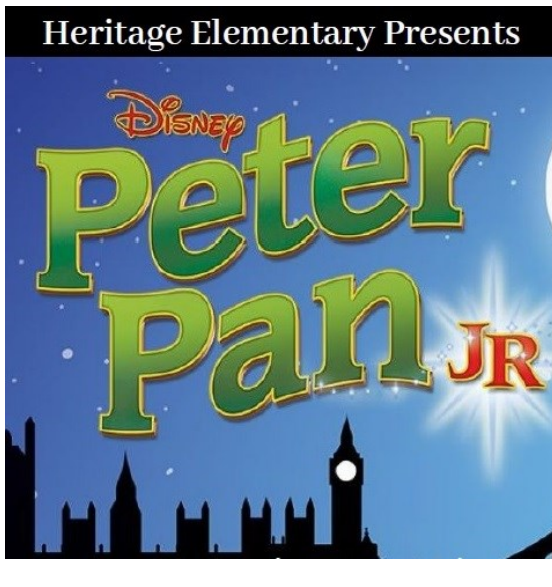

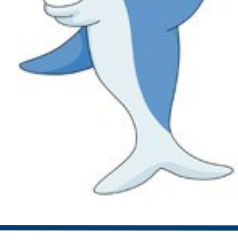
Immersion applications distributed beginning Tuesday, March 12th

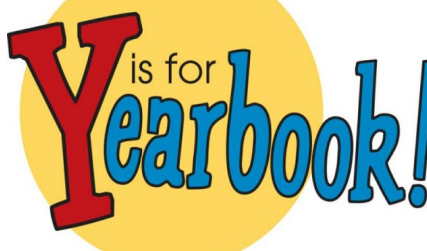
