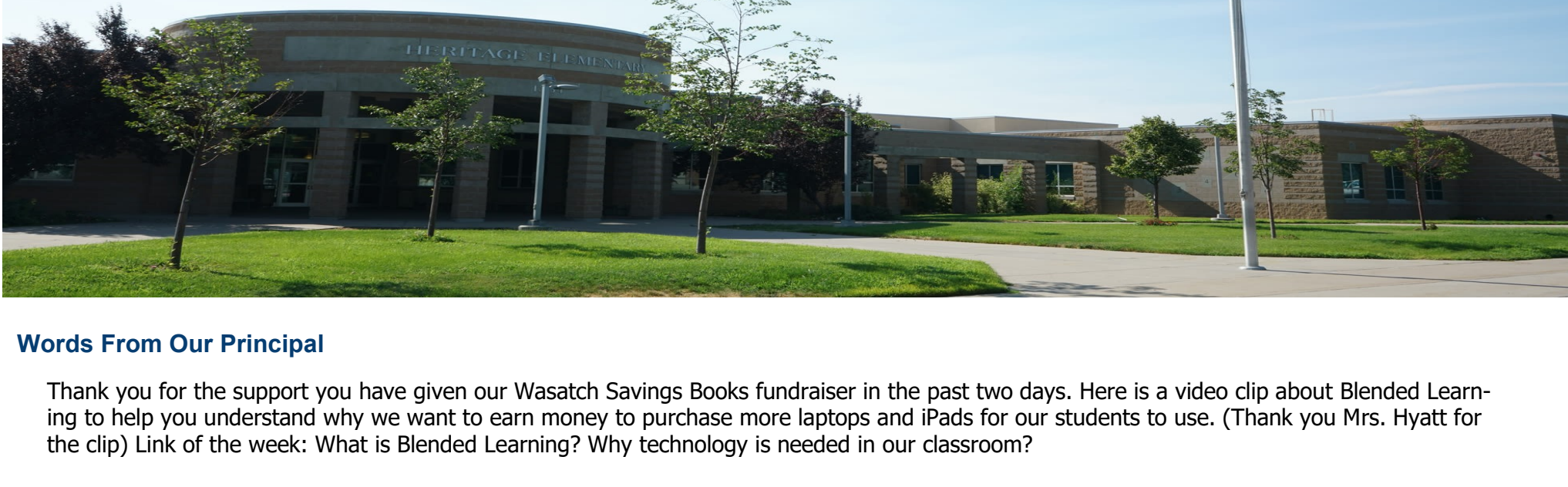

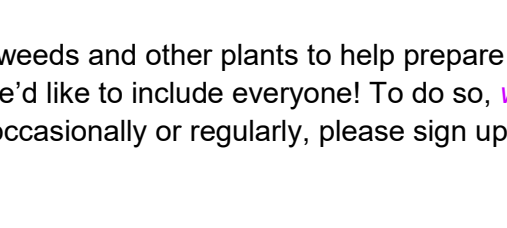

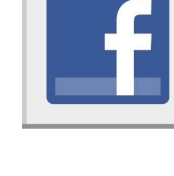

## School Beautification on October 17th, Donations Needed

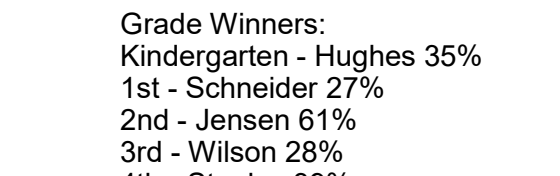

Heritage PTA has started a Facebook group! Be sure to go join the group for up-to-date announcements about what's going on. The group is called Heritage Elementary Layton PTA.



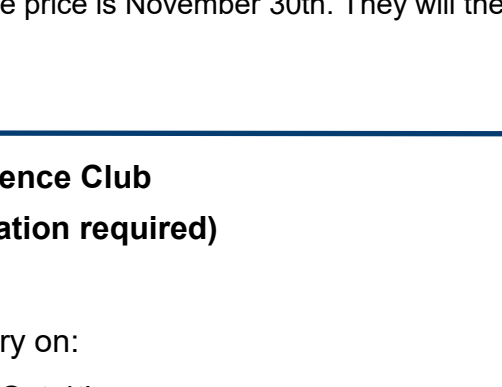

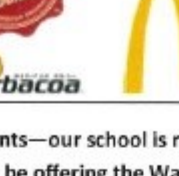
## The Fuel Your School program is back in Salt Lake, Davis and Utah counties in Utah!

Up to \$750,000 is available for eligible classroom projects.

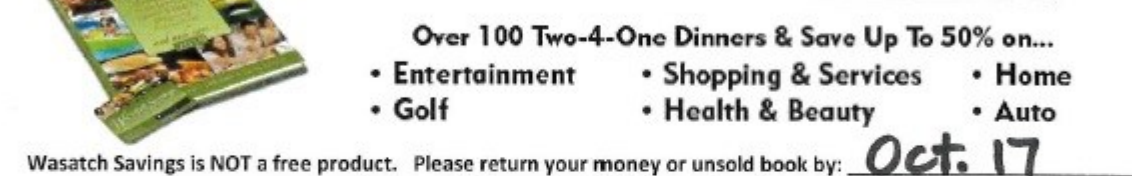

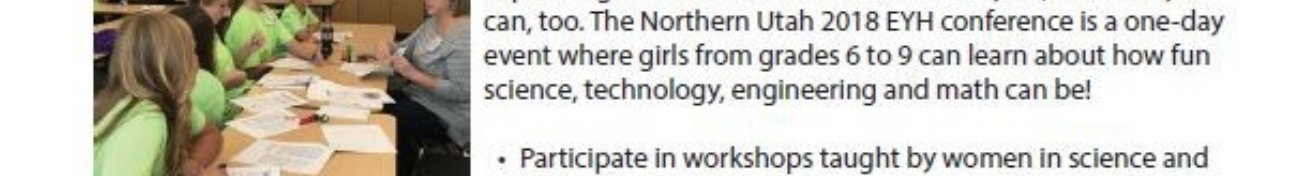

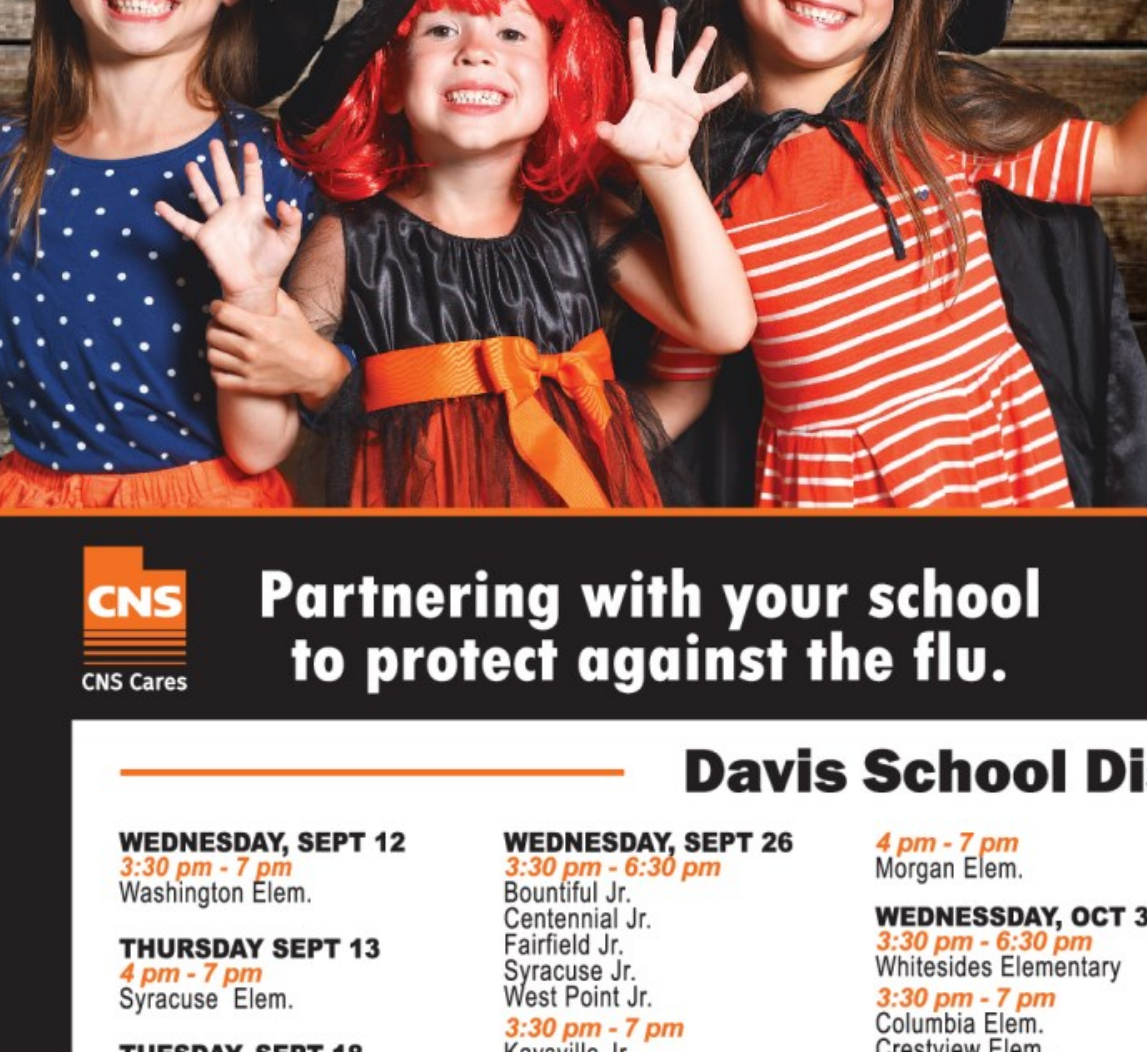
