COUNSELOR'S CORNER

Mrs. Roger's Counselor Corner—

educational and resource materials for parents and students.

Genuinely accept your child's concerns. Listen to your child's perceptions and gently correct misinformation.

Patiently encourage your child to approach a feared situation one step at a time until it becomes familiar and manageable.

Always try to get your child to events on time, or early – being late can elevate levels of anxiety.

Role-play strategies – how to react in certain situations. –Explore both best case scenarios and worst-case scenarios using realistic evi-

Try not to pass your own fears onto your child.

- Continually set equal expectations for all kids anxious or not. Expecting a child to be anxious will only encourage anxiety.
- dence. Help your child organize their school materials for the next day the night before.
- Allow and encourage your child to do things on this own. If a child is going to be singled out for a classroom activity, let that child know a day in advance so that he can feel more prepared.
- Set consequences don't confuse anxiety with other types of inappropriate behavior. Set limits and consequences so that you don't allow anxiety to enable your child. Have reasonable expectations.






