Guidelines:

Only currently enrolled (2021-22) **1st **through 6**th grade students may check out books. (Grade based on 2020-21 school year and only currently enrolled students who are listed in the library database are eligible for checkout)

Book check out policy: **3 books per visit. No additional books will be allowed out without the return or renewal of previously checked out material.

**Parents are strongly encouraged to attend the library with their students. ALL Non-school age children <u>will</u> require parent supervision.

**Other areas of the school are closed to all students/parents.

**Library behavior and etiquette will be expected.

**Book bag/backpack required to take books home. (Especially if traveling on bike/scooter)

How to participate:

There are several summer reading opportunities that we encourage you to participate in; Sora Sweet Reads (visit soraapp.com, use student email and password to login,) Deseret News /KSL/Governor's Office reading program (visit readtoday.com.) Book Your Summer Reading Award (visit bookyoursummer.com,) Davis County Library Summer Reading Program, and Barnes and Noble. Some of these provide incentives such as college scholarships, tickets to a Bees game, free books, online programs, and other prizes. Choose what best suits your family, or even better, use them all!
