



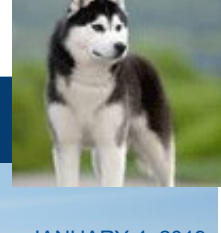

Welcome back! We hope you all had a wonderful winter break and a happy holiday season.

The beginning of a new year is a great time to review some safety procedures at Heritage and in Davis School District at large.

- Whenever you come to the school, you must check in at the main office, show your ID, and receive a visitor badge or volunteer badge. This is true for everyone.
- Please do not plan to just dash into the school to drop something off to your child's class. If you are bringing in lunches, library books, homework, etc., we will call students to the office to pick up these items. Not only is it a safety issue, it is disruptive to the class having parents "drop stuff off".

This is a policy we are strict on because it is for the safety of our students. School staff will be asking people who have forgotten to check in to go to the office to do so. Again, this is for student safety. Thank you for helping us enforce this very important policy.



You have undoubtedly noticed that it is cold outside. Please double check with your children that they come dressed for the weather each day. If the temperature is above 20 degrees and the weather and air quality are acceptable, students will be going out for recess. Students need the time outside of class to socialize, run, and play. Research shows that after a recess break, students are more attentive and better able to perform cognitively.

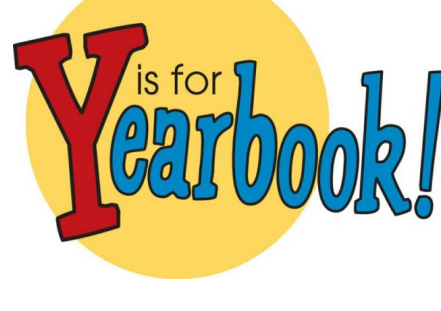

Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes:
SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, a referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers. If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.
