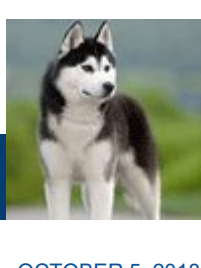

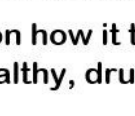

You can use any size or type of paper 8 1/2 x 11 or bigger. Please write your name, teacher, and grade on the back of your poster.

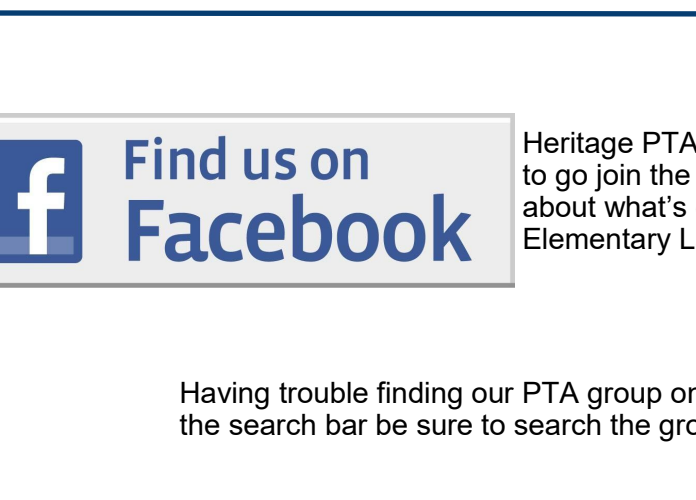
Due to cold weather and other conflicts we decided to cancel the Family Chalk Night. We are working on a different family activity for the fall.

Oct 15th 6-8pm

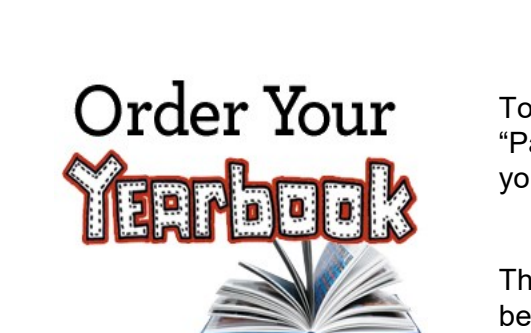
Bring your family, dinner, and some chalk if you have some at home.

The PTA will provide a dessert and we'll have extra chalk available.

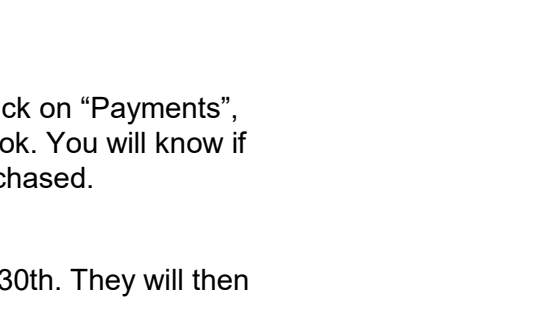


Thank you parents for your support with our Box Top store! We have earned **\$2,475.00!!!**

Garden Club Meeting – October 25th

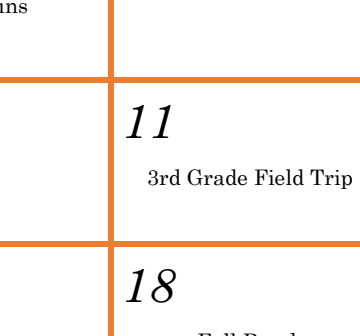

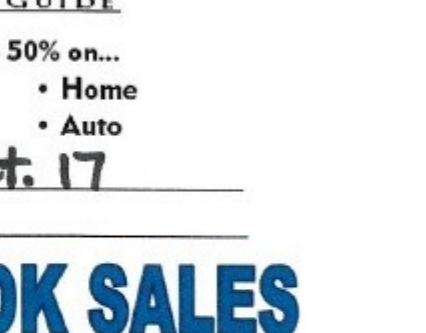


The Fuel Your School program is back in Salt Lake, Davis and Utah counties in Utah! Up to \$750,000 is available for eligible classroom projects.

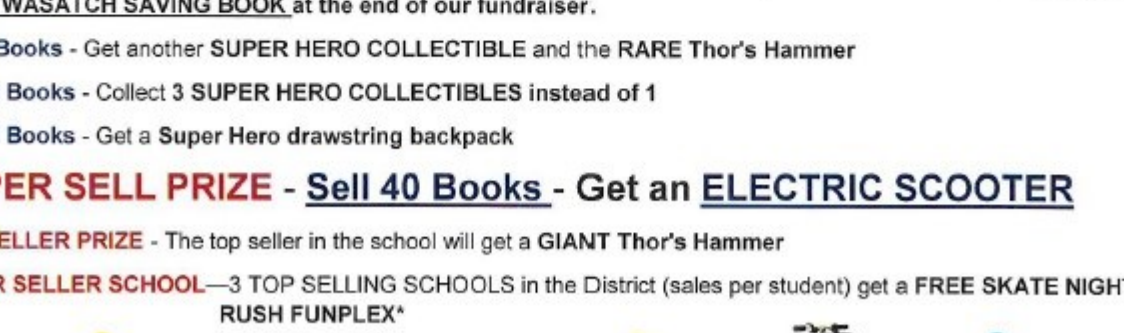

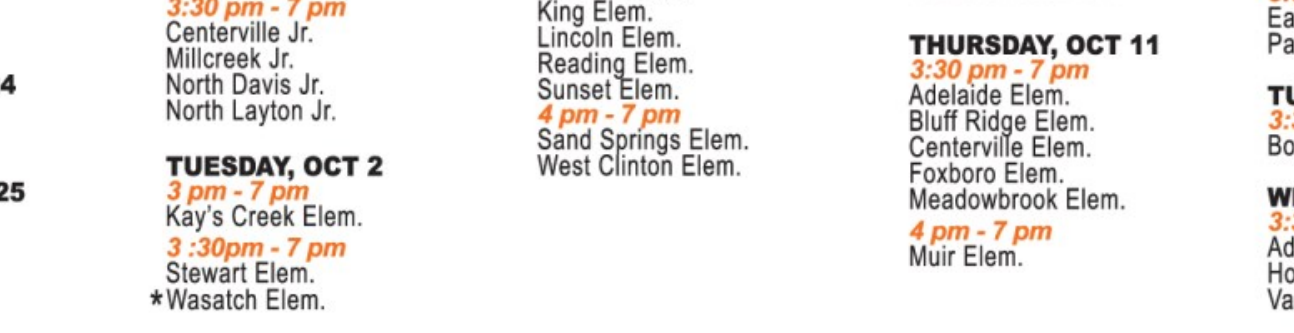

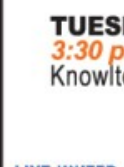
