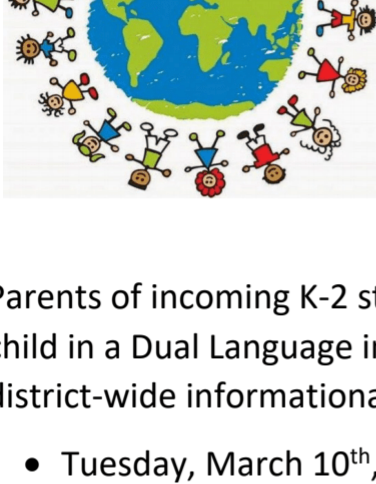
HERITAGE ELEMENTARY & SUNBURST ELEMENTARY

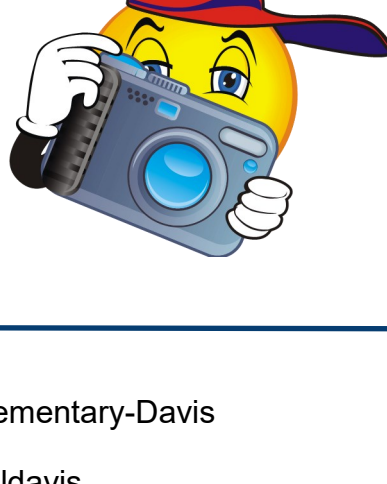

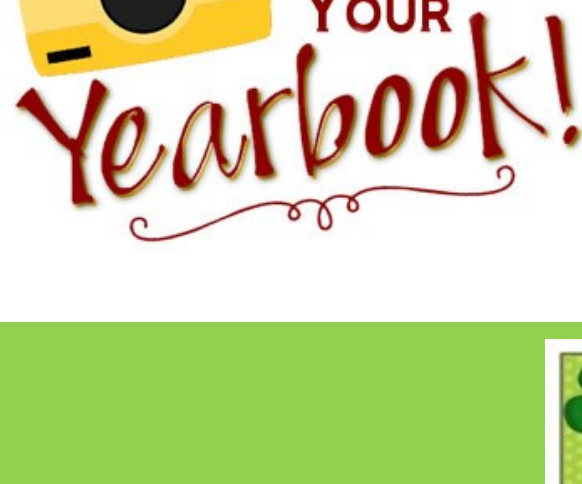

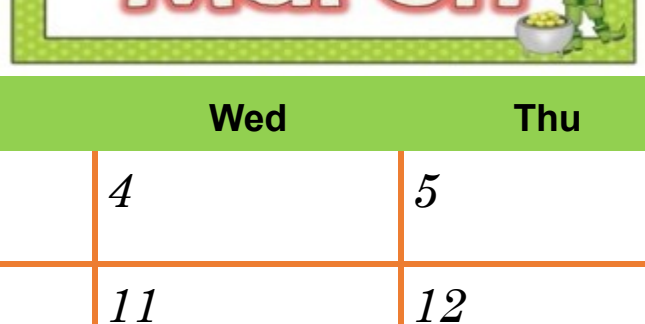
